INTRODUCTION.

The second volume of the records of the Dutch Reformed Saint John's Church in the town of St. Johnsville, contains about 475 pages, not all of which have writing upon them. The volume is bound in full calf, is of excellent paper and is in fine state of preservation. Although a few pages are missing from the book, there is every reason to believe that the record is complete. This transcript contains all of the second volume of the Church Record, with the exception of the Minutes of the Consistory, and original pages 457, 458, 459, 460, 461, 481 and 482. Aside from the Minutes of the Consistory, the items which have not been transcribed are of little or no consequence, as can be seen from the notes on pages 188 and 196.

The two books which have been transcribed in these two volumes, as also the Treasurer's Account book, and a book of Trustees' Minutes from 1873 to 1880, were received by the Society, on Feb. 24, 1914, from the Rev. Frederick Perkins, the Pastor of the Church. All four of these books of record, were returned to him, in the month of June 1914.

Given under our hands at Oppenheim this 6th day of July 1816.

A Call was executed on the Rev David Devoe from the Congregations of St. Johns Church in Oppenheim and St. Pauls Church in Memheim, which Certifies that he is to preach two thirds of the time in Openheim Church, and one third of the time in Memheim Church, viz two Sabbaths in St. Johns Church and one in St. Pauls Church, and in each year to preach twice a Sabbath for the space of five Months, and to perform such farther duties as is commonly performed by Ministers of the Dutch Reformed Church, and as a compensation for the performence of the above Duties the said Churches promis to pay the sum of Six hundred Dollars yearly and every year, in half yearly payments, so long as he remains the Minister of said Churches done on the 9th of July 1816. To preach half of the Sermons in German and the other half in English each and every year. Signed by the Elders and Deacons of both Churches.

Note. The last marriage was probably recorded at length by Mr. Devoe, on account of a law passed by the Legislature at about this time, which prescribed the form in which marriages should be recorded.

Note. Page 382 of the original record has no writing upon it. A leaf, consisting of pages 383 and 384, has been torn out of the record. It is my opinion however, that none of the marriage record is missing. The Rev. Mr. Lodewick was a slovenly record keeper; and if he tore this page out, he probably did not know any better, and was too careless to notice that the pages were numbered. This same trick has been done to a page in the Minutes of the Consistory, between Dec. 16, 1872 and Dec. 27, 1872, when Lodewick was keeping the record. I attribute both these cases to the same fault -- ignorance.
