Fredrick Getman	1751 - 1812	Capt Tryon Co Militia <sup>Y<sup>th</sup> REGT, POW</sup>
George Getman (father of Fred)	1723 - 1789	Pvt battle of Stone Arabia
George Horning	1765 - 1843	1st Reg't Battle of Oriskany
Diedrick Horning	1731 - 1827(?)	Ens and Pvt Battle of Oriskany (3 or 4 sons <sup>1<sup>st</sup> REGT</sup> killed)
